Such federal funding includes the National Housing Trust Fund (NHTF), the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), Small Cities/Community Development Block Grant (SC/CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). The FY 18-19 Action Plan represents approximately \$24M in federal funding for those five programs. A Public Hearing will be held, as listed below, to solicit comment on the DRAFT FY 18-19 Action Plan for Housing and Community Development. Additionally, input on performance under the aforementioned programs is also welcomed.
