The above captioned matter was scheduled for hearing on April 15, 1980 with #FIC80-66, K. J. Ring v. City and Town of Norwich; and Board of Education of the City and Town of Norwich, because the complaints concerned related subject matter and the same respondents. All parties appeared at hearing, at which time they presented evidence and argument on the complaints.

- 1. The respondents are public agencies within the meaning of §1-18a(a), G.S.
- 2. By letter filed with the Commission on February 22, 1980, the complainant alleged that sometime prior to February 5, 1980 the respondent board held an illegal secret meeting in violation of the requirements of §1-21, G.S., at which time a majority of the respondent board determined not to renew the contract of the superintendent of schools.
- 3. On February 5, 1980, the chairman of the respondent board had lunch with the superintendent of schools and informed him that there were five votes, a majority of the board, against renewal of his contract.
- 4. The superintendent called one of the board members subsequently and attempted to verify the chairman's remarks.
- 5. The aforesaid board member was unaware of a meeting to decide to terminate the superintendent's contract.
- 6. The chairman based his remarks at the February 5, 1980 luncheon on attitudes expressed by board members at previous meetings.
- 7. At a meeting of the respondent board on February 19, 1980, the board voted 5-4 in favor of a motion not to renew the superintendent's contract.
- 8. It is found that the complainant failed to prove that the matter of the termination of the superintendent's contract was discussed at an illegal secret meeting prior to February 5, 1980.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

The complaint is hereby dismissed.
