



Elementary Election Literacy

Lesson Name: Why is it important to participate in government?

Time Allotted: 30-40 Minutes

Essential Ouestions:

What rights and responsibilities do we hold as citizens of the United States?

Does my vote really make a difference?

Assessment of Mastery of Objectives:

Conduct an in class election or vote on a topic of choice.

Students will discuss the benefits of participating as a citizen and present opinions to the class or small group for open discussion.

Question or Problem for Students:

Can you support a decision that is made for you, or is it better to participate in the decision making process?

Special Directions for Cooperative Grouping:

- Students discuss rights and responsibilities of US Citizen. Background information can be found at

- Ask class about issues that they feel need to be changed within the class and create a list.
- As a group, poll to find the top two issues.
- Divide group in half, and assign each group an issue.
- Each group should come up with a solution, making sure that an agreement is met by majority rule.
- Have each group come up with an implementation plan and schedule for their solution.
- Have each group present and share solution and implementation schedule.
- Discuss as large group for agreement.
- Close by reviewing "Can you support a decision that was made for you, or is it better to participate in the process?"
